About The Team

Team Australia is a team of Australian cybersecurity students and young professionals. The team comprises of the Australian members of Team Oceania and other skilled individuals from around Australia. The team forms once a year to represent Australia as a guest team at the European Cybersecurity Challenge. Team Australia is seeking financial support to compete at the 2026 European Cybersecurity Challenge in Germany this October.

The European Cybersecurity Challenge (ECSC) is a prestigious Capture the Flag (CTF) competition that pits the sharpest cybersecurity minds from 35+ countries against each other in an intense multi-day format. The event is an initiative by the European Union Agency for Cybersecurity (ENISA) to enhance and discover cybersecurity talent across Europe and the globe. The competition tests skills across many areas of cybersecurity including cryptography, web exploitation, binary exploitation, reverse engineering, digital forensics, intrusion detection, networking, and automation.



Industry Support

Team Australia's attendance at ECSC is hugely dependent on support from the cyber industry. The nature of the European Cybersecurity Challenge presents a unique opportunity for sponsors to both gain high visibility international brand exposure and support the growth of the Australian cybersecurity industry. Sponsorship directly supports the future of Australia's national security and cybersecurity workforce. Sponsorship also establishes connections for talent acquisition and continued partnership with the team.

Team Australia is sending a delegation of up to 11 people (10 players and one coach) to Germany to compete in ECSC 2026 at an estimated cost of \$2800 AUD each, including return airfares and accommodation. With secondary expenses such as team shirts, banners, and equipment, the total cost for Team Australia to attend ECSC 2026 is estimated to be \$30,800 AUD. Self-funded travel is especially prohibitive for junior players, whom stand the most to gain from the incredibly valuable experience of competing on the global stage. Team Australia is appealing for industry support to get the team to Germany, and to contribute to the growth of Australia's cybersecurity talent.
